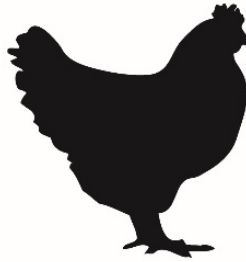

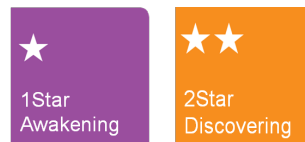
A. ResourceSmart Schools Progress

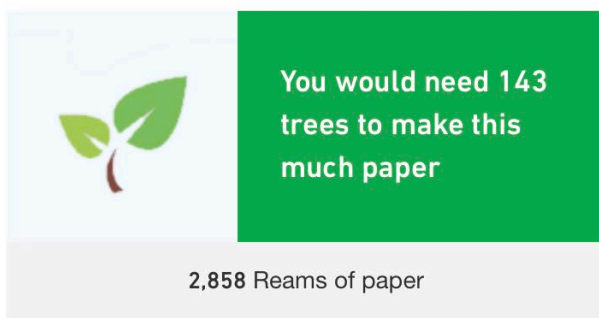
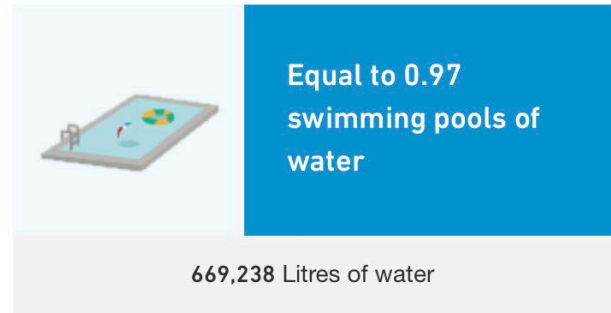
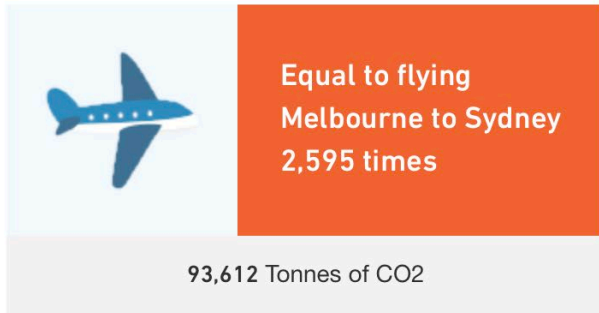

Since our baseline year of 2012 we have saved a total of **\$67,700.71**.
In the past 12 months, we have saved **\$28.71** per student.

C. Achievements

An achievement for this year is our school completing the Waste Module and receiving 2Star.

Our students also attended the Melbourne Water Kids Teaching Kids conference.

We applied for a grant with Northside Council for 100 seedlings to plant indigenous trees and flowers across the school.
